

Look back reviews of late diagnoses: survey of activity

BHIVA Standards of Care for People Living with HIV 2013 states:

All HIV services should undertake a review of all patients presenting to care with advanced immunosuppression (CD4 count <200 cells/mm3 or AIDS diagnosis), with "look back" of previous engagement with health care services. A summary should be provided to commissioners to aid greater understanding for interventions which can be implemented to reduce late diagnosis annually.

This survey seeks information about how HIV services have conducted such reviews for adult patients, and what impact they have had. It accompanies a casenote review of late-diagnosed individuals.
